
With truthful changes, us of fear of death.







Arrangement in Grey and Black No. 1, The Artist's Mother and Symphony in White, No. 1: The White Girl




Although my artwork is mainly considered representational, I deal with more metaphorical aspects rather than realistic physical evidence. The human body along with other elements: garments, fruit, vegetables, furniture, animals, etc. have been my focus. The images bear a slight resemblance to traditional Japanese Ukiyo-e prints, but also express contemporary aspects of the Western Hemisphere. PRESIDENTIAL PORTRAITS




